- IV. Public Hearing: Public Hearing on petitioned warrant articles:
  - **ARTICLE 5: BY PETITION:** Shall we modify the tax cap adopted under the provisions of RSA 32:5-b at the 2012 Annual Meeting to change the 2% tax cap to 3%? If this Article is adopted the governing body (or budget committee) shall not recommend a budget that increases the amount to be raised by local taxes based on the prior year's actual amount of local taxes raised, by more than 3%. (Passage requires a 3/5 majority ballot vote)
  - **ARTICLE 6: BY PETITION: TAX CAP RESCISSION:** Shall we rescind the provision of RSA 32:5-b, known as the tax cap, as adopted by the Newfound Area School District on March 13, 2012, so that there will no longer be a limit on increases to the recommended budget in the amount to be raised by local taxes? (3/5 Majority required)
